Crimea, 54% of voters supported independence.<sup>15</sup> Ukraine subsequently achieved recognition from the international community, including Russia, as an independent State. Although a part of the Soviet Union, Ukraine had been a separate Member State of the United Nations since 1945, and it remained so after seceding from the Soviet Union in 1991.<sup>16</sup>
